


**COOK'S KETTLE DEBUTS PATENTED SIGNATURE KETTLE
AT THE INSPIRED HOME SHOW 2026**



The Signature Kettle

CHICAGO (March 10, 2026) — Cook's Kettle® will debut its patented Signature Kettle, a timeless cast-iron cooking vessel engineered for effortless popcorn and everyday cooking, at The Inspired Home Show 2026, March 10–12 at McCormick Place in Chicago.

Inspired by pre-industrial round-bottom pots traditionally used in hearth cooking, the Signature Kettle features a patented interior geometry that uses gravity to guide kernels to the center of the cooking surface—producing perfectly popped popcorn without shaking, cranking, or electrical plugs.

A stabilizing base adapts the historic rounded form for modern stoves, delivering performance compatibility across electric, gas, and induction while supporting a wide range of culinary techniques including roasting, steaming, baking, and more. Constructed from durable cast iron, the vessel provides exceptional heat retention and distribution while introducing a distinctive alternative to conventional flat-bottom cookware.

The Signature Kettle has received positive early reviews from professional cooks and food writers, including Melissa Clark of *New York Times Cooking*.

Founder, Jennifer Gajewski-Heon explains, “In designing the Signature Kettle, I wanted to acknowledge the long history of cooking vessels while meeting modern expectations for performance and material safety. The result is a piece intended to endure—connecting past and present methods of cooking in a form built to be used for generations.”

The Signature Kettle is the debut product from Cook's Kettle and was inspired by Gajewski-Heon's Peace Corps service in Ghana, where round-bottom pots remain essential tools for daily cooking. In partnership with the nonprofit Cook x Cook, Cook's Kettle pledges a percentage of profits to the global nonprofit, Pure Earth, supporting efforts to eliminate hazardous contaminants from cookware in Africa and around the globe.
