Liddy Introduces a Licensable, Space-Saving Lid System Designed to Integrate with Existing Cookware Brands

Chicago, IL — March 2026 — Liddy, a modular and stackable pot-lid storage system, is redefining how cookware brands address one of the kitchen's most common pain points: lid storage. Designed to work with existing cookware rather than replace it, Liddy offers a licensing-ready solution that dramatically reduces cabinet and countertop clutter while fitting seamlessly into modern cookware portfolios.

Unlike traditional wire racks or drawer organizers, Liddy rethinks the lid itself. Two universal lids provide functional fit coverage across up to six common pot and pan sizes, storing vertically in approximately 3 inches of space—compared to roughly 24 inches required by typical lid racks. The system uses a simple quarter-turn interlock, detachable handles, and modular storage options designed to adapt to different kitchen layouts.

For in-cabinet use, an optional slim, enclosed drawer allows lids to be stored horizontally while remaining fully push-to-open. Designed to support stacking pots and pans on top, the drawer integrates discreetly into upper or lower cabinets without sacrificing usable storage space.

Developed through extensive physical prototyping and real-world kitchen testing, Liddy was created with licensing in mind. The system enables cookware brands to introduce new accessory SKUs without retooling core products, minimizing manufacturing friction while adding clear consumer value. A utility patent has been filed, and the Liddy™ trademark is registered.

Liddy is currently seeking licensing partnerships with cookware manufacturers and home brands interested in expanding their offerings through space-efficient, modular design.
